

## Unit 4: Soccer (Shooting)


**LEARNING

Ball between two, cones, goals, bibs.

**CLASS ORGANISATION**

STAGE	CONCEPT	CONTENT / ACTIVITY	TEACHING POINTS
Warm up		Ball between two. Pass and then go away before returning for pass.	Eyes meet before pass given. Give when it is on. Realistic turn around before coming back for the ball.
Development	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Creating space to shoot</li> <li>• Penetration</li> <li>• Support</li> <li>• Keeping possession</li> </ul>	<p>1. Increase size of area. Increase size of goal. Call shot game.</p> <p>2. <b>"Space to Shoot" game</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Each team stays in own half</li> <li>• Pass until space is created to shoot</li> <li>• A number of balls in each goal.</li> </ul>  <p>3. <b>3 v 3 Game (4 v 4 or 5 v 5)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• One player goes in goal leaving extra player on one team</li> <li>• Get a shot on target. Other team gets a go.</li> </ul> <p>4. <b>Game as in 1.</b> With greater focus on getting shots on target.</p>	<p>Recap of when to pass / shoot. Look for accuracy and power. Move towards instep shot. Head down, knee over ball.</p> <p>How can you make space for shots?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• vary passes - vary speed of passes</li> <li>• shoot on sight</li> <li>• set up shots</li> </ul> <p>How can you work as a team with an extra player, to create scoring opportunities?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• focus on building up play</li> <li>• do not just shoot from anywhere</li> </ul>
